April 14, 2010

The City Council met this date in regular session with Mayor Simpson in the Chair.

Roll call: Alstrom, Cook, Erak, Fritts, Gordon, Mills, Paling, Phelps, Schave, Shortt and Smith. Hoder absence excused. Motion to approve. Smith, Paling. Carried.

Motion by Smith, Mills to add 1 Public Works Report to agenda. Carried.

Motion by Schave, Phelps recommending approval and payment of accounts payable in the total amount of \$344,196.63 and payroll in the total amount of \$1,343,479.86; check numbers 22317 – 22347; 22518 – 22813 and wire numbers 732 & 733. Roll Call: 10 yeas, Alstrom abstained. Carried.

Report from Public Works and the Public Works Director recommending that VFW Post 224 be authorized to use the Lake Aberdeen Facilities on April 23rd & April 24th for their Annual Fishing Derby. Motion to adopt. Shortt, Mills. Carried.

Report from Public Works and Public Works Director recommending that the contract for Downtown Sidewalk Improvements, E.P. No. 5XS01/09, be awarded to Rognlin's. Motion to adopt. Shortt, Mills. Carried.

Report from Public Safety and the Fire Chief recommending that the Mayor and Finance Director be authorized to declare the Fire Departments digital AR337 copier surplus and purchase a Sharp MX3501N demo unit out of existing EMS reserves. Alstrom recused himself from discussion and vote. Motion to adopt. Fritts, Paling. Carried.

Report from Public Safety and the Chief of Police recommending that the Mayor and Finance Director be authorized to execute an extension of the current towing, impound and vehicle storage contract with No No's Tows. Motion to adopt. Fritts, Paling. Carried.

Mr. Moore, of Moore's Interiors Inc., was acknowledged for his generous donation of carpet and flooring to the Aberdeen Police Department.

Motion by Alstrom, Paling to appoint Margo Shortt to GH Tourism Council. Carried.

The Public Works Director presented a report from the Art Commission regarding action taken on two requests for donation of public art.

Mr. Dickerson reported that the Aberdeen Revitalization Committees are holding a downtown cleanup project this Saturday, April 17th. He also wanted to publicly thank Dennis Company, GH County, Boy Scouts, City of Aberdeen, LeMay Enterprises and Harbor City Church for donations for the event.

Motion by Smith, Paling at 8:20 to recess to executive session for approximately 25 minutes to discuss negotiations with the Association of Police Administrators Union (APAU). Carried. At 8:45 it was announced that an additional 5 minutes was needed.

Motion by Smith, Cook at 8:50 to reconvene in open session. Carried.

Motion by Smith, Alstrom to approve the two year agreement with APAU as presented and authorize the Mayor and Finance Director to sign the agreement. Carried.
