The City Council met this date in regular session with Mayor Simpson in the Chair.

Presentation to Aberdeen Girls Softball "10u Navy Team".

Roll call: Alstrom, James Cook, Jeff Cook, Hoder, Lawrence, Mills, Paling, Phelps, Schave, Shortt & Smith; vacant seat, Councilman Erak.

Motion by Hoder, Mills to approve the minutes of previous meeting. Carried.

Report from Public Safety added to agenda.

Motion by Jeff Cook, Schave recommending approval and payment of accounts payable in the total amount of \$252,483.26 and payroll in the total amount of \$1,400,582.89 check numbers 40590–40766. Roll Call: all yeas. Carried.

Report from Public Works and the Public Works Director recommending that the Timber sale contract for Wishkah Watershed 2013, unit #1 be awarded to Quinault Logging Corporation and the Timber sale contract for Wishkah 2013 unit #2 be awarded to Sierra Pacific Industries, and that the Mayor and Finance Director be authorized to execute both unit #1 and unit #2 contracts. Motion to adopt. Alstrom, Shortt. Carried.

Report from Public Works and the Public Works Director recommending that the staff be authorized to release the removed tree guards to original artists and for guards not picked up, staff would salvage or waste the remaining art pieces. Motion to adopt. Alstrom, Shortt. Carried.

Report from Public Safety and Fire Chief recommending that the Mayor and Finance Director be authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Department of Corrections contract No. K8629, to provide fire suppression services to SCCC. Motion to adopt. Smith, Lawrence. Carried.

Second reading and date of public hearing of Bill No. 13-04 repealing Section 9.02.050 of the AMC relating to aggressive begging. Public hearing opened. Hoder, Shortt. Carried. Hearing held; testimony taken. Public hearing closed. Hoder, Paling. Carried. Motion by Hoder, James Cook to pass to third reading. Carried.
