

July 8, 2015

The City Council met this date in regular session with Mayor Simpson in the Chair.

Roll call: Alstrom, Andrews, James Cook, Jeff Cook, Hoder, Lawrence, Mills, Paling, Phelps, Richrod, Schave & Shortt.

Motion by Schave, Paling to amend the minutes of the June 24th meeting to reflect that it was Andrews and James Cook who made the motion to adopt the Report from Public Safety authorizing the Mayor to sign the Multi-Jurisdictional Mitigation Agreement. Carried. Motion by Schave, Paling to adopt the minutes of the June 24th meeting, as amended, and the minutes of the July 1st meeting. Carried.

Motion by Alstrom, Jeff Cook recommending approval and payment of accounts payable in the total amount of \$599,873.52 and payroll in the total amount of \$1,393,632.15 check numbers 49032 – 49222. Roll Call: all yeas. Carried.

Second reading and date of public hearing of Bill No. 15-06 amending the official zoning map of the City of Aberdeen, being AMC § 17.08.020 as amended, by rezoning certain described property between Simpson Ave. and Sumner St., from Thornton St. to Myrtle St., from (C-R) Commercial Residential to (C-G) General Commercial. Public hearing opened. Hoder, Schave. Carried. Hearing held; public comment taken. Public hearing closed. Hoder, Shortt. Carried. Motion by Hoder, Shortt to suspend the rules, consider the second reading the third and place the bill in final passage. Roll call: all yeas. Carried. This will be Ordinance No. 6577.

First reading of Bill No. 15-07 adopting a six month moratorium prohibiting the licensing, location, and permitting of facilities for the wholesale storage and sales of liquid, solid, or gasified petroleum in the City of Aberdeen, State of Washington. Discussion followed. Motion by Andrews, Jim cook to pass to second reading. Roll call: 8 yeas; 4 nays (Hoder, Mills, Phelps & Schave). Carried.

Motion by Andrews, James Cook to refer the zoning issues in the moratorium to the Planning Commission. Discussion followed. Motion carried. Corporation Counsel, Eric Nelson, clarified that referring the zoning questions to the Planning Commission now, does not affect the moratorium or change the six month time line. Motion carried. (Schave opposed).

Second reading and date of public hearing of Bill No. 15-09 authorizing the operation of wheeled all-terrain vehicles (WATV) in the City of Aberdeen and adopting a new chapter in the AMC regulating the use of WATV within city limits. Public hearing opened. Andrews, Jim Cook. Carried. Hearing held; no public comment. Public hearing closed. Andrews, Jim Cook. Carried. Passed to third reading. Andrews, Jim Cook. Carried.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
