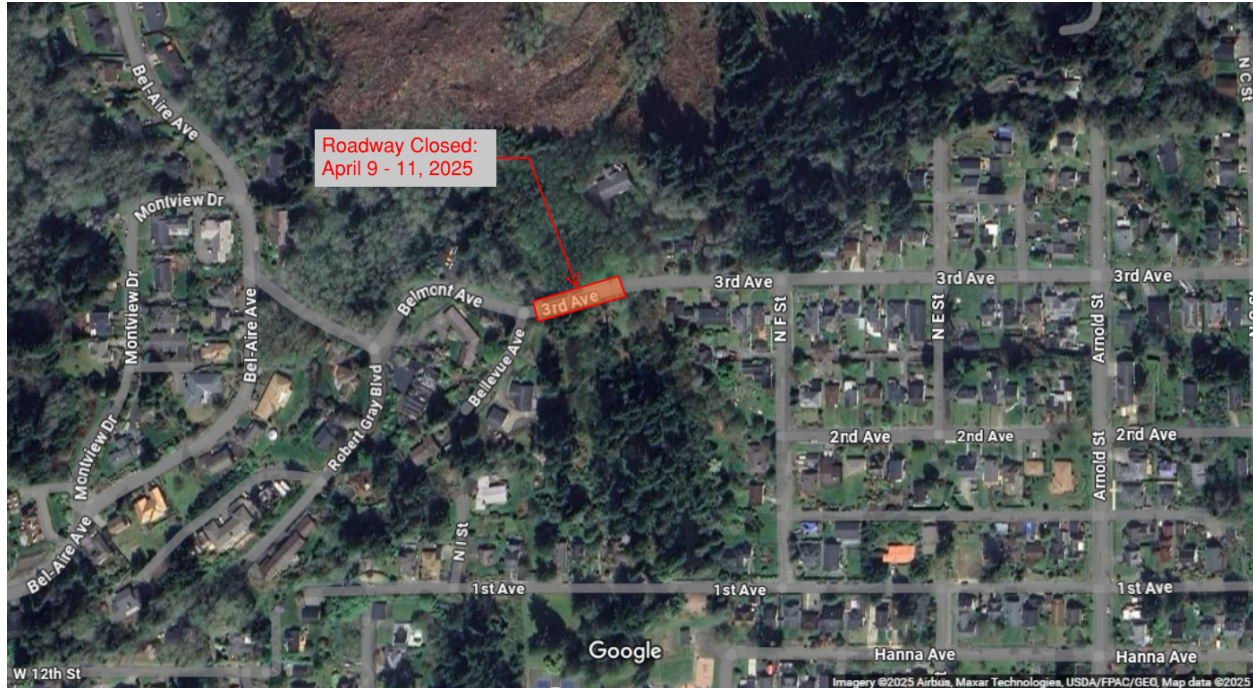

City of Aberdeen
Waterline Replacement and Upcoming Slide Repair on 3rd Avenue



Aberdeen, WA – April 07, 2025 – Beginning April 9, 2025, the City of Aberdeen will start replacing a section of an existing waterline between Bellevue Avenue and N F Street. This work is a necessary step ahead of planned slide repairs scheduled for this summer. To ensure the safety of workers and the public, 3rd Avenue will be fully closed during this time. The closure will remain in effect until all work is complete and safety measures are restored. We encourage motorists and pedestrians to use alternate routes while the closure is in place.

Later this summer, additional construction will begin to repair the segment of 3rd Avenue that was damaged during a slide in January 2022. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has recently authorized the City to move forward with these critical repairs. The City will provide advance notice of construction impacts once the slide repair schedule is finalized.

We appreciate your continued patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure. For your safety, please stay alert, watch for traffic control devices, and obey all construction signs and flagging personnel.
