NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Aberdeen is proposing to update the City's adopted Shoreline Master Program (Aberdeen Municipal Code chapter 14.50). The City and the Washington Dept. of Ecology (Ecology) are accepting comments on a periodic review in accordance with RCW 90.58.080(4) and pursuant to the joint review process set forth in 173-26-104 WAC. The City has prepared draft Shoreline Master Program (SMP) amendments to be consistent with state law, local plans, regulations, and other changed local circumstances. Proposed amendments to the SMP are limited to changes to the Shoreline Management Act and related rules, and some limited modifications to reflect changes to local circumstances. Public comments will be accepted from May 22, 2023 to June 22, 2023 (at 5 pm). Send comments to City staff contact Lisa Scott (contact information provided below). Comments sent to the City will be forwarded to the Dept. of Ecology.
