ABERDEEN FIRE DEPARTMENT ISSUES BURN BAN

ABERDEEN, WA –



Effective 12:01 AM, Friday, July 12, 2024, due to the continued trend of dry and warm weather and the associated increase in fire danger, the Aberdeen Fire Department is enacting restrictions on all outdoor burning within the city limits until fire conditions improve.

All outdoor burning, including recreational campfires, charcoal and wood burning are prohibited until further notice.

The use of natural and propane gas burning self-contained camping stoves or grills and natural or propane gas burning portable fire pits are allowed.
