Minimum Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age.
- Valid Washington State Driver's License, or ability to obtain one by date of hire.
- High School Graduate or GED.
- Ability to pass extensive background checks to include criminal, psychological and medical screening.
- IFSAC Firefighter I
- Washington State or National Registry EMT Certification with the ability to obtain State Certification
- Current CPAT

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APPLICATION PROCESS

Application/Written Exam: Visit [National Testing Network](#) to apply. Complete the firefighter written exam through National Testing Network, a passing score of at least 70% is required.

Physical Agility Exam: Proof of completion of a current Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) required to be considered as qualified at time of Oral Board Interviews. Upload certificate to your National Testing Network application.

Oral Board Interview: When the need to establish Civil Service Firefighter/EMT Eligibility List arises, the top scoring qualified candidates will be invited to participate in an oral board interview conducted by the Aberdeen Fire Department. A passing score of at least 70% is required on the oral board interview. Candidates with incomplete applications or no valid CPAT will not be considered.

Selection Process: When the need to fill a vacancy from the Firefighter/EMT eligibility list arises, the Fire Chief will interview the top scoring candidates for consideration of filling the vacancy.
