### US 101 Safety Improvement Project

The City of Aberdeen is launching an exciting transportation improvement project designed to enhance safety, accessibility, and mobility for all road users! The project will improve access to our schools, parks, transit stops and local businesses on the south side of Aberdeen.

#### Project Details:

**Location:** US 101 Highway from the South End of the Chehalis River Bridge to Cosmopolis

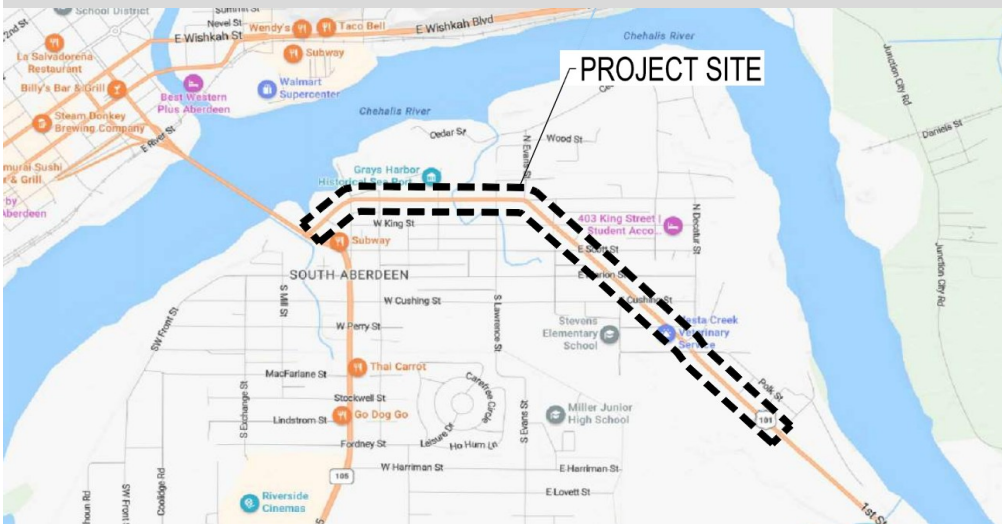
**Project Length:** 1.44 miles

**Estimated Construction Timeline:** Spring 2026 - Fall 2026

#### Project Highlights:

- Filling in sidewalk gaps for a continuous pedestrian path
- Adding and/or replacing deficient ADA curb ramps to improve accessibility for all users, including individuals with disabilities
- Installing bulb-outs at intersections for safer pedestrian crossings
- Introducing buffered bike lanes to promote safe cycling
- Reducing four lanes of two-way traffic to two travel lanes with a center two-way left turn lane for improved traffic flow and safety

- ⇒ **Enhanced Safety** – The primary focus of this project is to create safer streets by calming traffic and reducing conflicts between vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists, thereby lowering the risk and severity of accidents.
- ⇒ **More Accessibility** – New curb ramps and complete sidewalks ensure mobility for everyone.
- ⇒ **Better Traffic Flow** – A dedicated left-turn lane reduces collision risk and improves overall traffic efficiency.
- ⇒ **Community Friendly** – Enhanced pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure promotes a healthier and more active community.
