



2020 Utility Rate Increases


The City Engineer and Public Works Director have identified specific capital improvements necessary to provide sanitary sewer, domestic water and stormwater utility services that are safe, effective, reliable, and in compliance with applicable laws. To pay for utility capital improvements, the City Council has adopted Ordinance 6655 establishing a five-year schedule of utility rates. **The first rate change is reflected on this bill.**


Single-Family/Duplex Residential

The bill for a TYPICAL single-family residence located inside the city limits will be calculated as shown below.



****Most RESIDENTIAL bills will have a total of \$ 110 - \$130****

Fixed charge \$ 33.48 (water only)
add'l charge \$ 2.36*
(*per 100 cf used – up to 1,299 cf)

Your monthly bill will vary based upon water consumption.
*Additional charges will apply to consumption in excess of 1,300cf.



Customers who are low-income senior citizens may be eligible for a 20% discount of the fixed monthly rates for water and sewer. Forms are available at City Hall or can be mailed to you by calling (360) 537-3210.

In accordance with Title 13 of the AMC, garbage service is compulsory and mandatory upon all persons, dwellings and business establishments within the City. For garbage service, changes & questions call LeMay of GH (360) 533-1251.
